Where two physical isomerides of a substance exist, the optical activities of the two varieties are usually equal and opposite. The specific rotation commonly assigned to lsevo-pinene is--40. 4 (--43. 4 being the greatest activity observed), while pinene from American oil of turpentine is stated to have a specific rotatory power of 21. 5 for the sodium ray. From these figures it would appear that one or other of the pinenes is not a homogeneous substance. J. H.
